

Gospel Bracelet Booklet

The color **WHITE** represents Jesus' sinless life (see 2 Corinthians 5:21; 1 Peter 1:18, 19).

The color **BLACK** represents both our sins and the hopelessness of trying to save ourselves (see Titus 3:3-5a; Galatians 2:16b; Ephesians 2:8, 9; Romans 1:18-32; Romans 3:10-24; Revelation 9:20, 21).

The color **YELLOW** represents the fact that Jesus died for all men and is the only way to heaven (see Acts 4:12; 1 Timothy 2:3-6; Acts 17:30, 31).

The color **GREEN** represents Jesus' resurrection and our future resurrection (see 1 Corinthians 15:17-22; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:51, 52; Acts 17:30, 31; Acts 2:32; Acts 3:26).

The color **BLUE** represents eternal life as a free gift from above (see Revelation 22:17; Ephesians 2:8, 9; John 4:10).

The color **PURPLE (OR AMETHYST)** represents a believer's gratefulness for having been thoroughly saved from everlasting destruction (see 2 Thessalonians 1:9,

Once our sins, which separated us from God are removed, we have eternal life and begin a relationship with God, and it is by the power of His Spirit, who takes up residence within us, that we begin to put to death our sins and to do the things that God wants us to do.

God removes our dirty clothes (our sins) and remembers them no more. This is possible because Jesus paid the price for our sins by His death on the cross. God then clothes us with clean white robes (the perfect righteousness of Jesus). And that is possible because Jesus never sinned.

Read the passages listed within. Doing so may well be the best thing you have ever done or will ever do! Believing them will be the best thing you have ever done or will ever do!

The first verse reference listed within is 2 Corinthians 5:21 which says: "For He has made Him who knew no sin, to be sin for us, that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him." This is the greatest exchange known to man. It is what happens to those who believe that Jesus is God, trust that He paid the penalty for their sins (past, present, and future sins), and desire to have God change them so that they can begin to love others in a way that was impossible for them before. Here is the exchange explained a bit more:

The color **PINK** represents the fact that Jesus is our Creator God and was born as a human being (see John 1:1-3, 14a; Hebrews 1:8; Titus 2:11-14).

The color **RED** represents the shedding of blood of our Lord's once for all, only acceptable sacrifice (see Hebrews 9:22; Hebrews 10:10-18; Ephesians 2:13).

The color **WHITE** represents the fact that ALL of a believer's sins are washed away (see Isaiah 1:18; Colossians 2:13).

The **HEART** stands for God's love and Christians' love for one another (see Romans 5:8; 1 John 3:14; 1 John 4:7).
